

THE GOAL OF THE PRSI GAFC PROGRAM

Our program is designed to serve residents of affordable housing developments with the goal to assist them to remain living in their home as long as possible. The GAFC program provides assistance with activities of daily living (ADL) and instrumental activities of daily living (IADL) to eligible residents. Daily services include personal care, housekeeping, laundry, shopping, meals, transportation coordination, and case management.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR GAFC SERVICES?

Program participants must meet all of the following criteria. There is no direct cost to the participant; the program is third-party paid by Medicaid.

- 22 years of age or older
- Insured by Medicaid (MassHealth)
- Approved by MassHealth for GAFC services
- Need daily assistance with personal care
- Approved by their physician for GAFC services
