## INTRODUCTION

When you reside in your housing community not only do you enjoy quality maintained and managed housing, you may also have the option to participate in a variety of supportive services. The goal is to enable the resident to remain living safely and comfortably in their home as long as possible.

Residents needing assistance with activities of daily living can benefit from the *Peabody Resident Services Group Adult Foster Care Program*. Eligible residents may receive essential services such as personal care, housekeeping, laundry, shopping, meals, and a 24 hour personal emergency response system-- at home in your own apartment.

## WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR PEABODY RESIDENT SERVICES GROUP ADULT FOSTER CARE SERVICES?

Program participants must meet all three criteria:

- ♦ Insured by Medicaid (MassHealth) and approved by Medicaid for GAFC Services
- ♦ 22 Years of Age or Older
- ♦ A medical diagnosis, need daily assistance with personal care needs, and approved by your physician for GAFC services.

## WHAT IS THE FINANCIAL COST?

The Group Adult Foster Care Program is covered by Medicaid. There is no direct cost to the participant.

## HOW DO I LEARN MORE ABOUT GROUP ADULT FOSTER CARE?

The Resident Service Coordinator meets with the resident to discuss their individual care needs and the eligibility criteria for the program.

A referral is made to our home health care agency partner by the Resident Service Coordinator. The Resident Service Coordinator and the agency's Registered Nurse conduct an assessment to determine the type and frequency of services you may need. An individual Care Plan is developed with the approval of your physician, and consistent with program guidelines.
